Our Lady of Beaurang  
Banneux, Patroness of Belgium.  
The Image of Immaculate Heart of Mary.  
Two separate Apparitions, 1932-1933.  
Symbol of Belgium - Belgian Flag.

## Chapel Windows

**England:** Our Lady of Walsingham, Patroness of England. The Image of Our Lady seated with child Jesus. Medieval Title for England: *Our Lady's Dowry*.  
New Nazareth at Walsingham Shrine, 1061 AD.  
Symbol of England - Royal Crest and English Flag.

**Scotland:** Our Lady of Scotland, Patroness of Scotland.  
The image of Our Lady, Madonna of the Highlands.  
Crown and Cross of St. Andrew. St. Columba,  
Apostle of Scotland, 597 AD.  
Symbol of Scotland - Scottish Flag.

**Australia/New Zealand:** Our Lady of the Pacific,  
Patroness of Oceania. The Image of Our Lady.  
Symbol of Australia - Koala Bear.  
Symbol of New Zealand - Kiwi Bird.  
Oceania - Fiji Islands and Polynesia  
Founding of St. Mary's Cathedral, Sydney, 1834  
AD.  
Symbol of Australia - Australian Flag.

## Have Windows

**U.S.A.:** Our Lady of LaLeche ("Our Lady of the Milk"). The Image of Our Lady nursing the Infant Jesus. This devotion to Our Lady, Patroness of Nursing Mothers, was established at the Mission of Nombre de Dios (Name of God), St. Augustine, Florida in 1565 AD.

This Window also includes the National Symbol of the American Eagle and the American Flag.

**Canada:** Our Lady of the Cape ("Cape de La Madeleine") Quebec.  
The Image of Our Lady, Queen of the Holy Rosary, Patroness of Canada. Church of the Holy Rosary miraculously transported across frozen river in April, 1883 AD.  
The Maple Leaf and the Canadian Flag symbolize Canada.

## Mexico:

Our Lady of Guadalupe,  
Patroness of Mexico and Latin America. The Image of Our Lady with roses symbolizing the Guardian of Pre-Born Children and the Pro-Life Movement.  
Juan Diego, was the Messenger of Our Lady at Tepeyac Hill, Mexico City, 1531 AD.  
Symbol of Mexico: Mexican Flag.

**Ireland:** Our Lady of Knock, Queen of Ireland. The Image of Our Lady with St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist, and the Lamb of God at Knock (Hill), County Mayo, Ireland 1879 AD.  
National Symbols of Harp and Shamrock and Irish Flag.

**Spain:** Our Lady of Monserrat, Patroness of Spain.  
The Image of Our Lady and Infant Jesus. La Morenata, Image darkened by candles' smoke, 718 AD.  
The Symbol of Spain - Spanish Flag.

**Poland:** Our Lady of Czestochowa, Patroness of Poland, The Black Madonna. The Image of Our Lady with Infant Jesus with slash marks on the face of Our Lady inflicted by Hussites. Pauline Monks at Jasna Gora Monastery victorious against invading Swedish soldiers in 1655 AD.  
The Symbol of Poland: Polish Flag.

**Italy:** Our Lady of Loreto, Patroness of Italy. The Image of Our Lady and Infant Jesus with Holy House of Nazareth (Casa Sancta) being transported by Angels to Loreto, Italy, 1294 AD.  
The Symbol of Italy: Italian Flag.

**Germany:** Our Lady of Bavaria, Patroness of Germany. The Image of Our Lady and Infant Jesus. Frauenkirche (Cathedral Church of Our Lady) Marienplatz, Munich. The origin of Munich was a Monastic Site. End of Thirty Years War, 1648 AD.  
The Symbol of Germany: German Flag.

**France:** Our Lady of LaSalette, Patroness of France.  
The Image of the Weeping Madonna, Reconciler of Sinners 1846 AD.  
National symbols of France are the Fleur de Lis (Lily) and the French Flag.
