Celebrant: <u>Catechumens</u>, now with your sponsors receive the sign of your new status as a Catechumen.

Celebrant: (physically) traces the cross on the forehead of each catechumen with his thumb and then invites the sponsor to do the same.

Celebrant: prays the following:

(N) Receive the Cross on your forehead. Christ himself strengthens you with the sign of his love. Learn to know and follow him.

-- SIGNING OF THE FOREHEAD OF THE CANDIDATES --

Celebrant: Dear <u>Candidates</u> for reception into full communion, now with your sponsors receive the sign of your life in Christ.

Celebrant: (physically) traces the cross on the forehead of each

<u>Candidate</u> with his thumb and then invites the sponsor to do the same.

Celebrant: Prays the following:

(N) Receive the cross on your forehead as a reminder of your Baptism into Christ's saving death and resurrection.

-- CONCLUDING PRAYER -

Celebrant: Let us pray.

Almighty God, who through the cross and Resurrection of your Son, have given life to your people, grant we pray that following in the footsteps of Christ, your servants, whom we have signed with the cross, may possess its saving power in their lives and show it forth In their deeds.
